## PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING: APRIL 20, 2010

Y	Y	Y	Y	Y	N	Y	The Planning Commission approved a conditional use permit for a 10-screen / 1400 seat movie theatre, approximately 33,000 sq. ft, and 2350 sq ft of retail space and 4300 sq. ft. sit down restaurant on 1.5 acre site with no on-site parking.
The Commission granted the removal of the 18' height restriction to allow for the 40' structure and 2, 72' towers. They also granted the road abandonment of a portion of Atascadero Mall and easement along El Camino Real. The Commission added 40 regular and 6 handicap parking places be secured within a 500' area from the perimeter of the theatre project. The final build out from Traffic Way to the Creek south will provide 133 parking spaces on site.
